When you speak of true MCs, **ALI STARR** should be mentioned. This Salem "Sale City," NJ MC has been polishing his craft for years to a fine finish. Grinding for years promoting himself through performing in shows, selling CDs from the trunk city to city. From sleeping in his car, car accidents, deaths in the family to being stranded in California after a bus trip from Philly, PA are just some of the stepping stones and obstacles that he has faced...and triumphed over.

BIO

Born and raised in Salem NJ, Ali Starr saw the rise and demise of friends and family, what the neighborhood brings while trying to rise in the game of HipHop. From signing his first indie deal with indie label Chedda Hill Records through a meeting via local producer Big Majik (RIP) garnered him tristate notoriety. His first hit "Can't Get It Together" lead to appearing on POWER99 The Come Up Show, countless other shows, POWER99 Back to School Jam with Cassidy, the Beatnuts, to 103.9 concert with Eve, The Roots, Dragon, Black Moon, to POWER99 Power House concert with Busta Rhymes, DMX, Cameron and more. Ali would also be featured in The Source Magazine & TV show, The Source Sound Lab with Master P, Wutang Clan, Ray J, Mobb Deep and more. This would lead to later connecting with neighborhood friends Sillawet & DJ Chill forming the group BBG which led to a management deal with Fullmoon of Wutang Clan Sunz Of A Man label Lunar Shine Entertainment and a record deal with Kgm Ent. From this, countless shows opportunities started coming in such as the USO Tour, singles, interviews and an album.

After this Ali Starr would hit the reset button take leadership grinding and rebranding along with Lunar Shine Entertainment, which later became a label WuFam Fullmoon Productions, making ALI STARR the first signed artist to the new imprint. This would lead to movie soundtracks, TV performances and appearances on Home Of Hip Hop NY, BigMan Ent TV show, Rap World, BET, MTV, VH1, concerts, radio interviews (POWER 99 FM, 103.9 Philly, POWER 105, HOT97, iHeart Radio, WuWorldRadio and more.

Ali Starr would achieve a Hollywood Music Award nomination for "Dip Ya Head Back" performed by ALI Starr & Sillawet and would embark on the 1 month-long USO Tour for the US troops in the UK. He would secure a distribution deal with VP records VPAL music, making ALI Starr the first US Hip Hop artist to sign with a reggae label, releasing the single "Bad Mommi," a Hip Hop infused reggae song which he performed for thousands at the Jamaican festival in Queens, NY. "Bad Mommi" is currently streaming on all platforms.

Along the way, Ali would produce a host of mixtapes which he pressed up himself and distributed in the streets, city to city, from his car, hand to hand selling. He also dropped the mixtape "LOT36," an ode to the legendary WuTang Clan which included Hip Hop's giants Ghostface Killah, Killah Priest, Sonny Seeza of Onxy, Napoleon Da Legend and reggae giant Sizzla. Five videos were released from the project and also earned ALI Starr a #1 position on N1M charts. Ali Starr has also filmed for a TV series entitled "Undeniable," which will premiere soon. Ali Starr also performed along with Junior Mafia and Onxy at the MTV Yo! MTV Raps 30th Anniversary held at the Barclays Center in Brooklyn, NY. He currently has 2 songs, "Work It" produced by Kingsley Gardner and "Dip Ya Head Back" from the motion picture soundtrack "Gender Bender," currently streaming on Amazon.

Ali Starr has since been featured on the single and video "I Made It," also featuring King Tiger, a song currently streaming on all platforms, and also featured on the platinum compilation Billboard album series "Tropical House Cruises To Jamaica: The Reggae Collections Edition." The single hit #19 on the Caribbean/ Cuba charts, the album hit number #16 on Billboard, and was considered for a Grammy. It went on to reach #1 on iTunes in over 13 countries, making Ali Starr a Billboard and Grammy considered artist. The album recently hit the 4 million stream mark

and still going! With the momentum rolling, Ali Starr teamed up again with King Tiger, Melodiq, Fullmoon and Hip Hop's heavy weight Red Man to release the anticipated follow up single and video "Wingz Up," Produced by Ali Starr. Since its release, "Wingz Up" as a single and video has over 2 million streams combined. "Wingz Up" has since charted #95 and #1 on iTunes South Africa Hip Hop/ Rap charts, South Africa's overall top 200 at #17 & #14, Switzerland top 100 HipHop/ Rap #41 & #16, United Kingdom HipHop/ Rap #61 & #21 and has even garnered a spot on Billboard at #25. The track is featured on a DJ Symphony (Gza of WuTang Clan DJ) mixtape and has also been added to the score and soundtrack for the new highly anticipated film "DOGGMEN," directed by Antonio Simmons, starring Hip Hop's iconic legend DMX before his untimely death. "Wingz Up" will also be featured on the new Compilation platinum Billboard series "Tropical House Cruises To Jamaica: The Asia Edition" with Lauryn Hill, Chris Gayle, Capleton, King Tiger, Fullmoon, Sizzla, Jason Darulo, Red Man and many more! With all the momentum, Ali Starr is taking advantage of it. Ali Starr also caught the acting bug with three movie roles in "New Jack Empire" (Children of Harlem), "Blood Mixed" and "She's Broken" all scheduled to premiere year.

Today, the WuFam Billboard Grammy considered recording artist and now producer has released his new single and video "Spirit Of A Hustler," featuring Fullmoon, produced by Fullmoon & Co and Ali Starr. The single dropped on Aug 21, 2022 on all streaming platforms and the video was been released on Sept 8, 2022. Ali Starr has performed his new single at Chelseas Music hall along with Jim Jones, Maino, Math Hoffa, Nems, Lil Momma and more. Ali Starr has also performed his new single alongside the likes of J Cole, Lil Wayne, Rick Ross, Nas, Post Malone and Lauryn Hill just to name a few. He also performed his single at the famous Couples resort in Ocho Rios for Jamaica's zip 103 FM concert show. "Spirit Of A Hustler" is currently streaming on all digital & video platforms and the video has been the most requested on Rap World Videos. It continues to rise in streams, sales and is projected to hit the iTunes and Billboard charts in 2022. It's a project with hard hitting kicks and smacking snares along with a deep baseline complimented by Ali's unique rhyme style and word play...he won't disappoint Hip Hop fans throughout the world.
